

## Threat of Arson or Risk of Arson External Agency Guidance

When any professional becomes aware of an individual who has been threatened with arson, who is at risk of arson, or that has been directly attacked using fire as a weapon, they should contact Royal Berkshire Fire and Rescue Services (RBFRS).

- During office hours Safeguarding Team
- During evenings, weekends' and bank holidays Royal Berkshire Fire and Rescue Service Duty Officer. This can be done through our Thames Valley Fire Control Service (TVFCS) who will assist in making arrangements to conduct a Threat of Arson Safe and Well Visit at the property (with consent from the individual).

RBFRS have a commitment to attend these visits within 48 hours where possible.

## What is a Threat of Arson/Risk of Arson Safe and Well Visit?

A Threat of Arson/Risk of Arson Safe and Well Visit will add extra precautions into the home using a variety of risk specific measures which can be utilised when a threat of arson has been made against a person or their property:

- Providing and installing free 10-year smoke alarms. Particular emphasis is given to fitting additional alarms near to external doors.
- Giving practical and lifesaving advice on identifying and reducing fire hazards and reacting to fire situations in the home.
- Fitting an arson proof letterbox (locking letter plate) where necessary. If an arson proof letterbox does not fit the size or design of the letter box, then a fire retardant throw can be provided to place on the floor by the front door.
- Providing fire retardant spray, fire retardant throws, fire retardant nightwear (pyjamas and nighties) and fire retardant bedding where necessary.
- Detailing and discussing bespoke escape plans with the individual. This may include evaluating and checking which windows are suitable for escape use.
- Assessing the property both internally and externally with a view to reducing the potential for fire.
- Following the receipt of a Threat of Arson referral, we will place a marker against the address on our systems for awareness.
